Standards and Expectations

Dear Parent/Carer,

As we look forward to the new academic year, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support with the Academy's drive to continuously raise standards. I am immensely proud of our school and I am delighted to be working together with parents and carers to ensure the best possible learning experience for our pupils.

As you are aware, we are very ambitious for our school community and we will always strive for excellence in all areas. On a daily basis our first priority is to ensure every child is safe. You will be fully aware of our traditional values and our high aspirations for all pupils who attend Lord Derby Academy.

As we continue to move the school forward from September 2018 onwards, I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of some of our key expectations:

Key items for the school day:

Your child must arrive to school fully prepared for the day ahead. All pupils **must** have:

- A school bag
- A planner (to be issued on the first day back)
- A dictionary
- A reading book
- A pencil case containing:

Black pen x 2

Green pen

Pencil

Ruler

Eraser

Yellow, Green, and Pink Highlighters

Scientific Calculator

Pencil cases that include the items (except the calculator) listed above can be purchased in school from Student Services for £1. Scientific calculators can also be purchased at school at a discounted price of £5.

Year 7 pupils

Year 7 pupils will be provided with all the key items (except the calculator), including a dictionary, on arrival to school, however they will need to purchase a scientific calculator on the first day if they have not already done so.

Attendance and Punctuality:

Attendance and achievement are very closely correlated and it is proven that pupils with high attendance achieve higher grades. We expect all pupils to arrive on time by **08:38am** and to aim for attendance of **at least 98%** in order to maximise all learning opportunities.

The school **cannot** authorise holidays during term time and reserves the right to issue Fixed Penalty Notices in association with the School Attendance Service for periods of unauthorised absence and persistent absence without medical evidence (10% overall absence). Please be aware that holidays taken during term time will not be authorised and may incur a Fixed Penalty Notice.

Any child who is absent from school for 10% of the time is defined as a 'persistent absentee' and the school will act upon this, issuing consequences in line with our Attendance Policy for pupils who fall into this category.

Uniform:

Pupils should travel to and from school in full school uniform.

School shoes must be plain black shoe style with leather upper. Boots, smart trainers, multi-coloured shoes and footwear with coloured piping, logos, soles and laces are **not permitted**. Please note **if it looks like a trainer it is a trainer**. Please see the separate letter attached from Mrs Cundle regarding appropriate footwear.

Black socks are to be worn in school at all times, this includes P.E. lessons.

Outdoor coats should be removed when on site and can be placed in the cloakroom area.

Hooded tops are **not allowed** and will be confiscated if brought into school.

All pupils must have the established school kit for every P.E. lesson and parents/carers are responsible for replacing any items of lost kit.

Parents/Carers are able to buy tracksuit bottoms/fleece tops from the school kit range. Non-school items are not allowed.

Jewellery:

Pupils are **not allowed** to wear any jewellery other than a watch. **No piercings of any kind are allowed. Pupils who have piercings/studs must remove them during school hours.**

Haircuts:

Extreme haircuts (e.g. shaved No.1) and colouring, which is in stark contrast to natural tones, **are not acceptable**. Long hair past the shoulders must be tied up. Ribbons and headbands must be plain black, white, grey or burgundy and only small in size. Long hair in the face is not permitted. Fringes must be cut above the eyes or secured by a clip so as not to impede vision.

Make-up:

The wearing of any type of make-up, including false eyelashes, false nails and nail varnish etc., **is not allowed**. This includes permanent and semi-permanent make up. Please be aware, false tan **is not allowed**.

Chewing gum:

Is a banned item and must not be brought into school.

Mobile Phones and Electronic Devices (including Smart Watches):

These are not permitted on the school site. If it is necessary for a pupil to bring an electronic device into school, such as a mobile phone, it must be signed in on arrival to school at Student Services otherwise if it is seen, it will be confiscated. If an electronic device is confiscated it will only be given back to a parent or carer. Pupils must not access a device belonging to another person.

Drinks:

Pupils can only bring water into school. Water should be contained in a clear, plastic bottle. A range of healthy drinks can be purchased from the school canteen. Bottles must not exceed 750ml.

Parent Pay:

Please note that all parents/ carers should now be using Parent Pay as a means to top up a pupil's money for food. If you need your details reissuing, please contact Student Services on 3rd September 2018. In the short term, pupils can top up using cash if necessary.
